



OVERVIEW OF PROTECTIVE SUPERVISION

During the time you are protecting the incapacitated person you will determine their different needs and ensure that action is taken to meet them. Although you will not provide the required services yourself, you are responsible for ensuring that he or she receives them. At times it may be difficult to monitor the situation.

You may find the chart below useful in determining the different needs of the person under your protection and keeping track of the steps you have taken. It is an excellent way to inform the tutorship council on how you are fulfilling this important task. We suggest that you complete this overview and give it to the tutorship council at the same time as your annual report, and discuss its contents together. You don't have to send it to the Curateur public.

Material needs and daily needs (e.g., clothes, food, furniture, technical aids, etc.)
